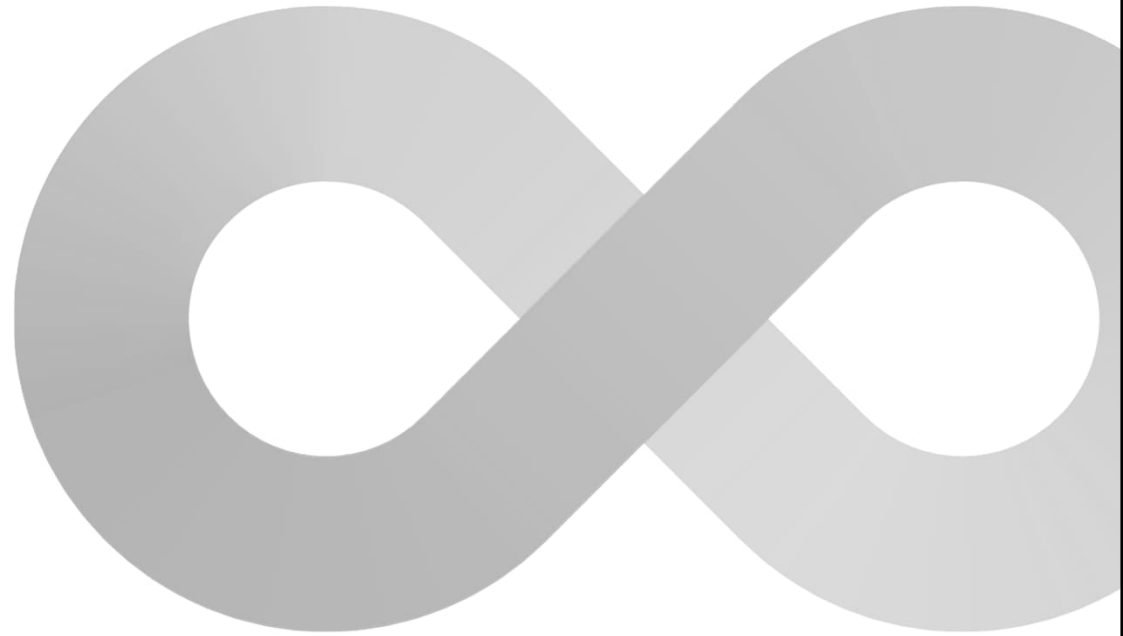

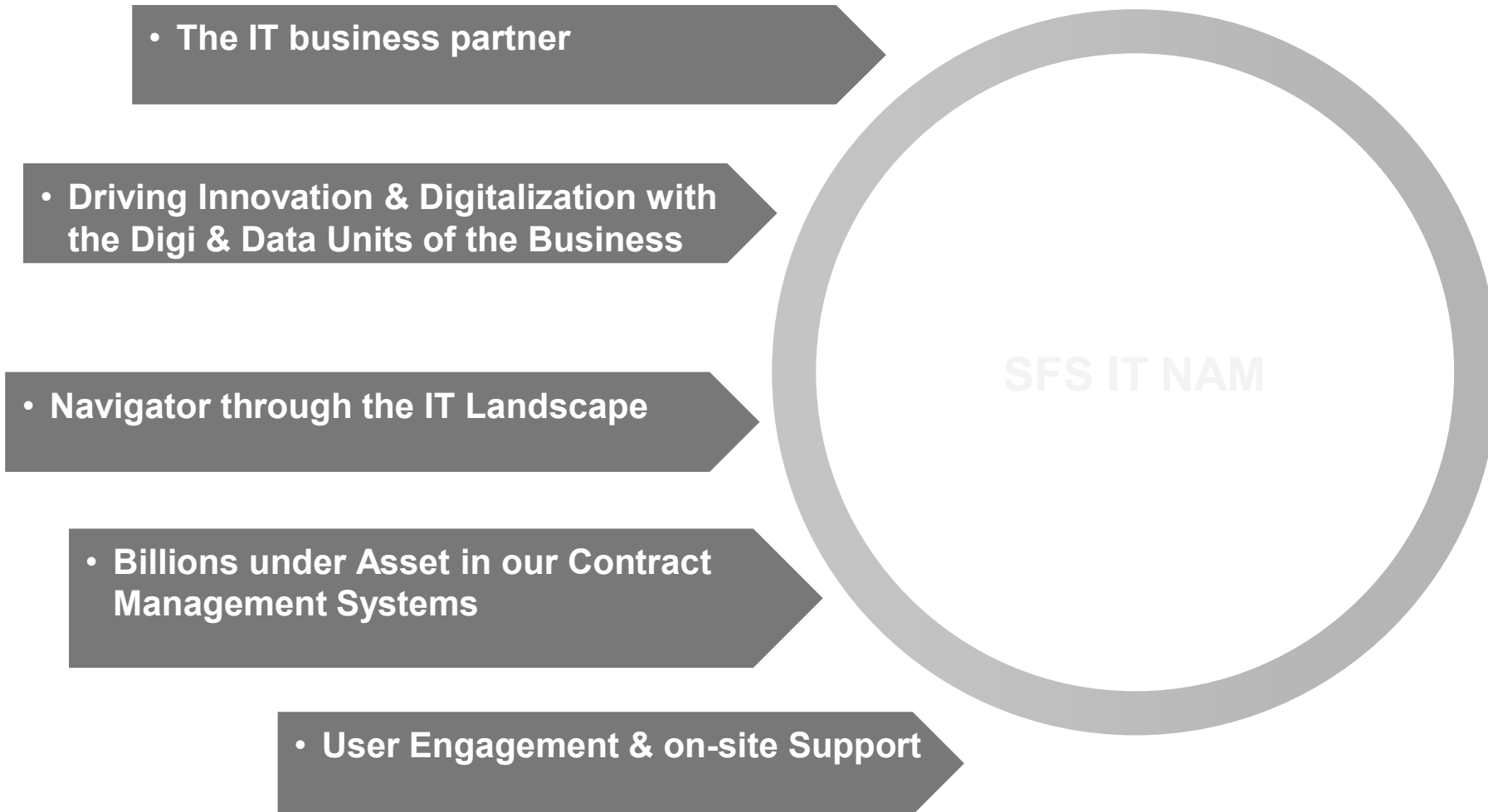

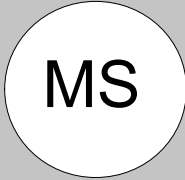

- From Munich to Iselin and Malvern to London and back to Iselin



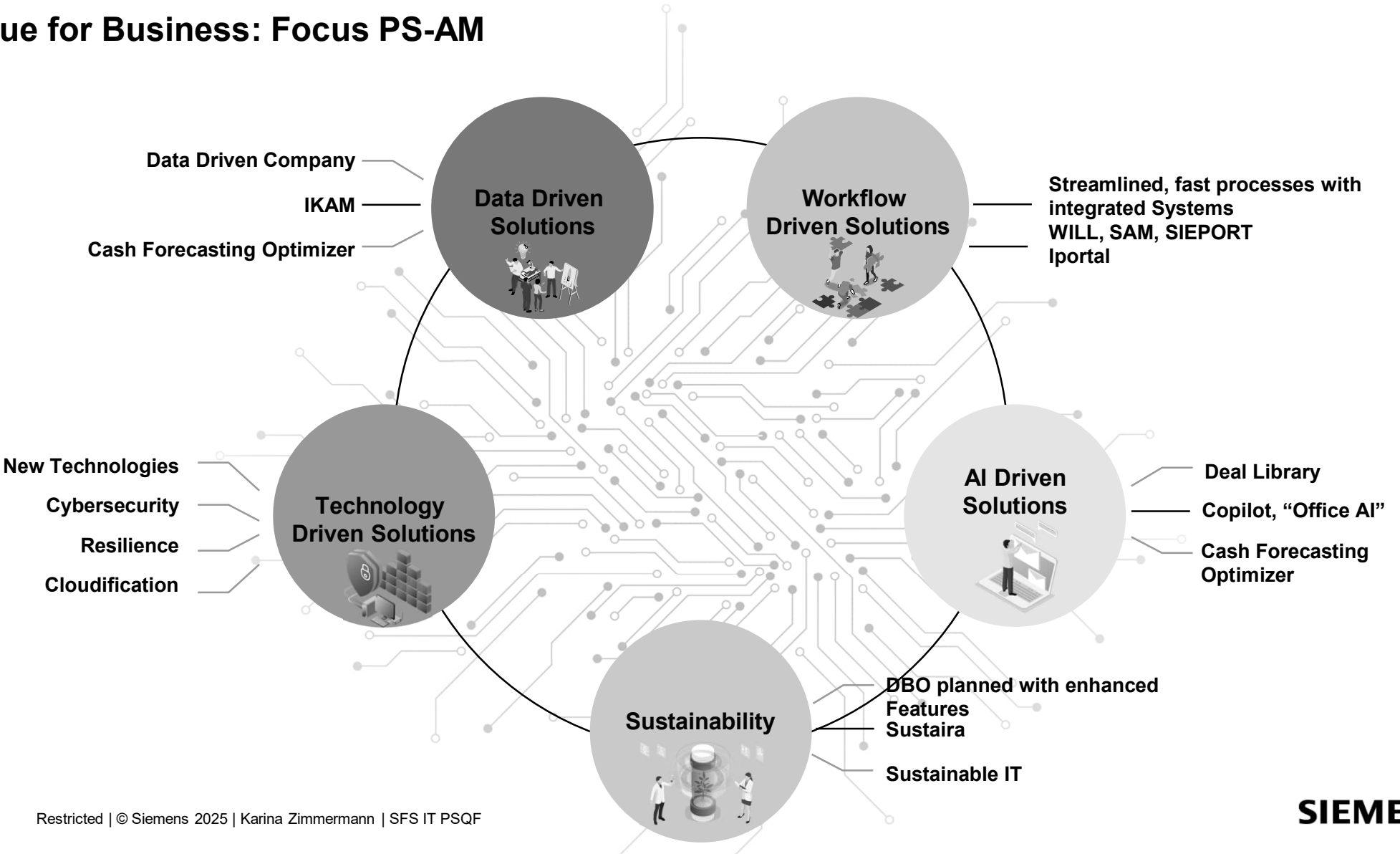
Why SFS and Siemens

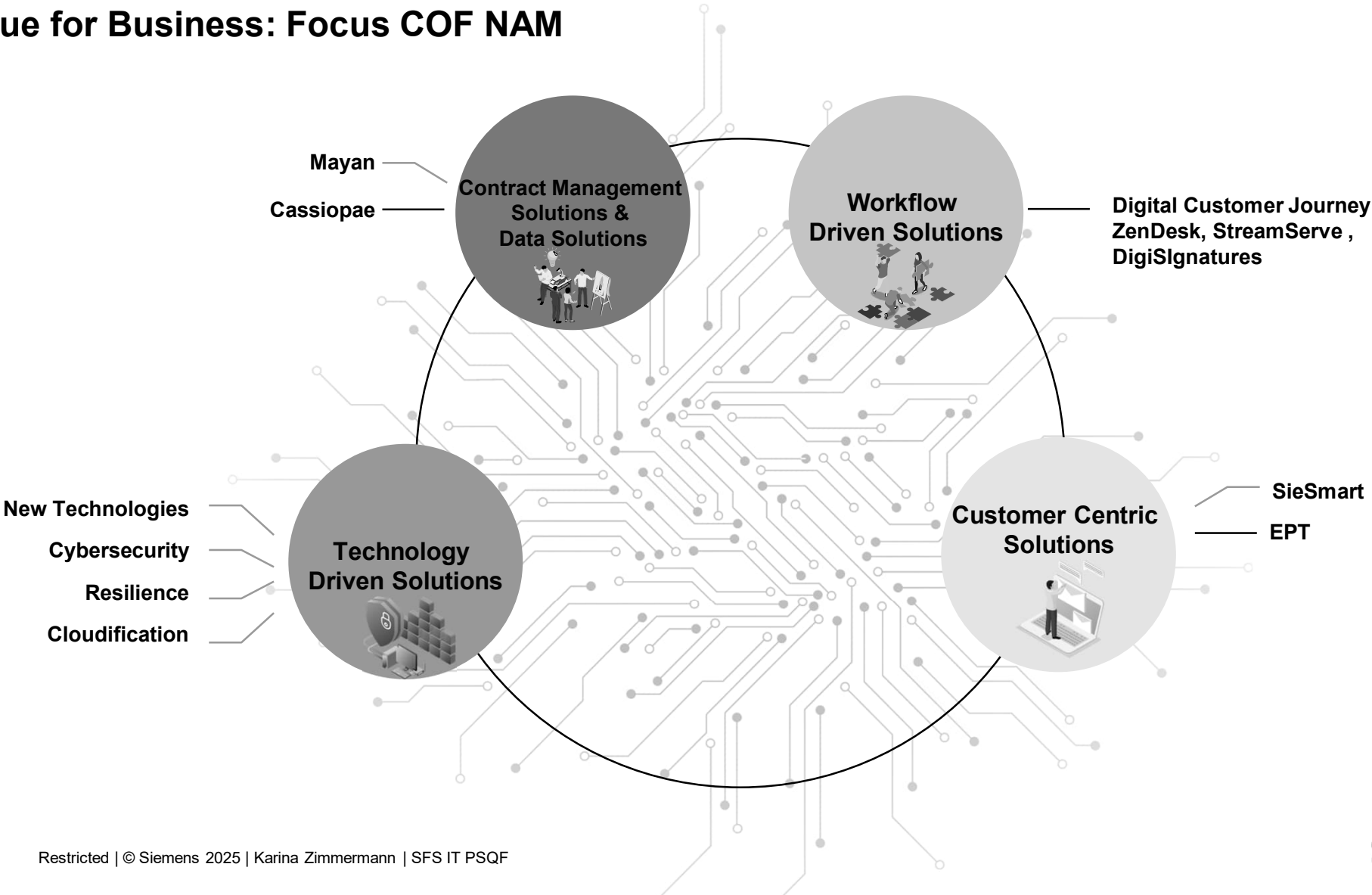
