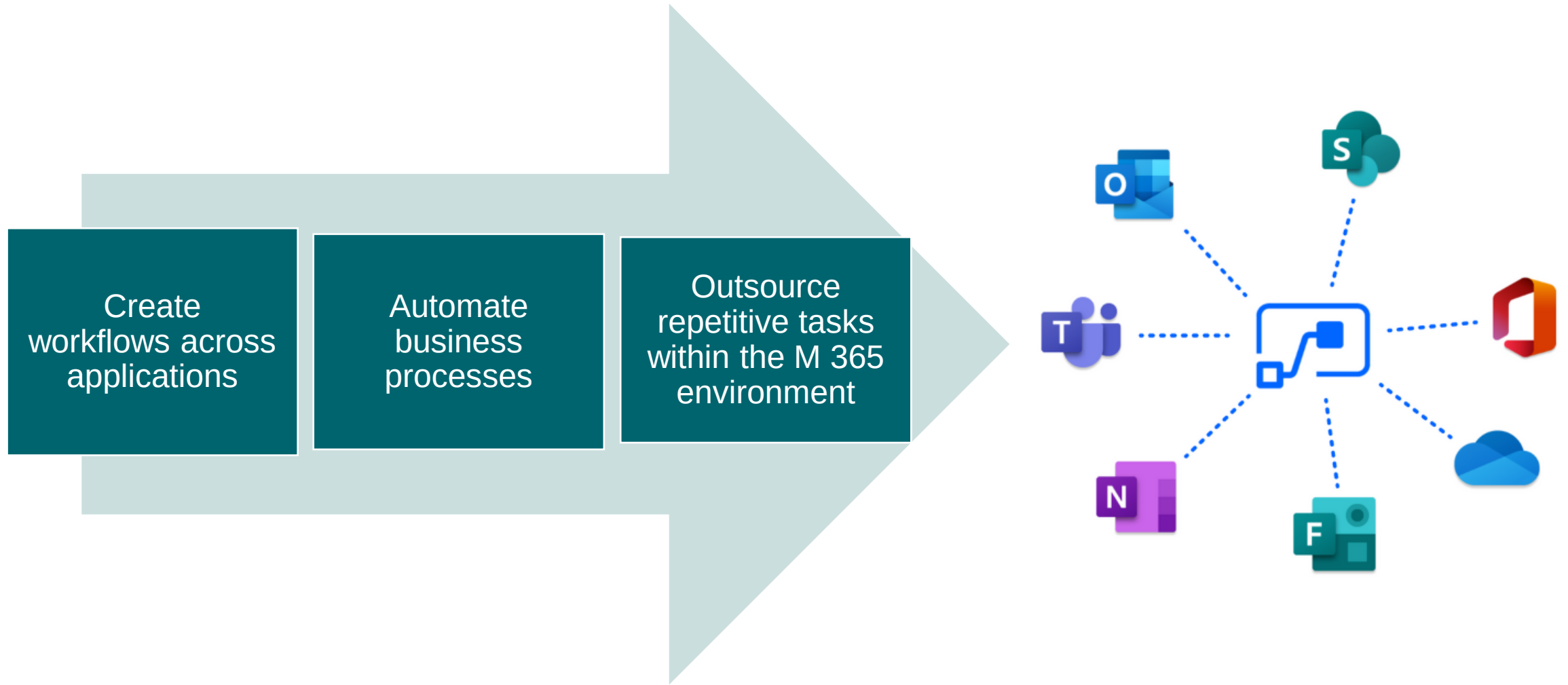

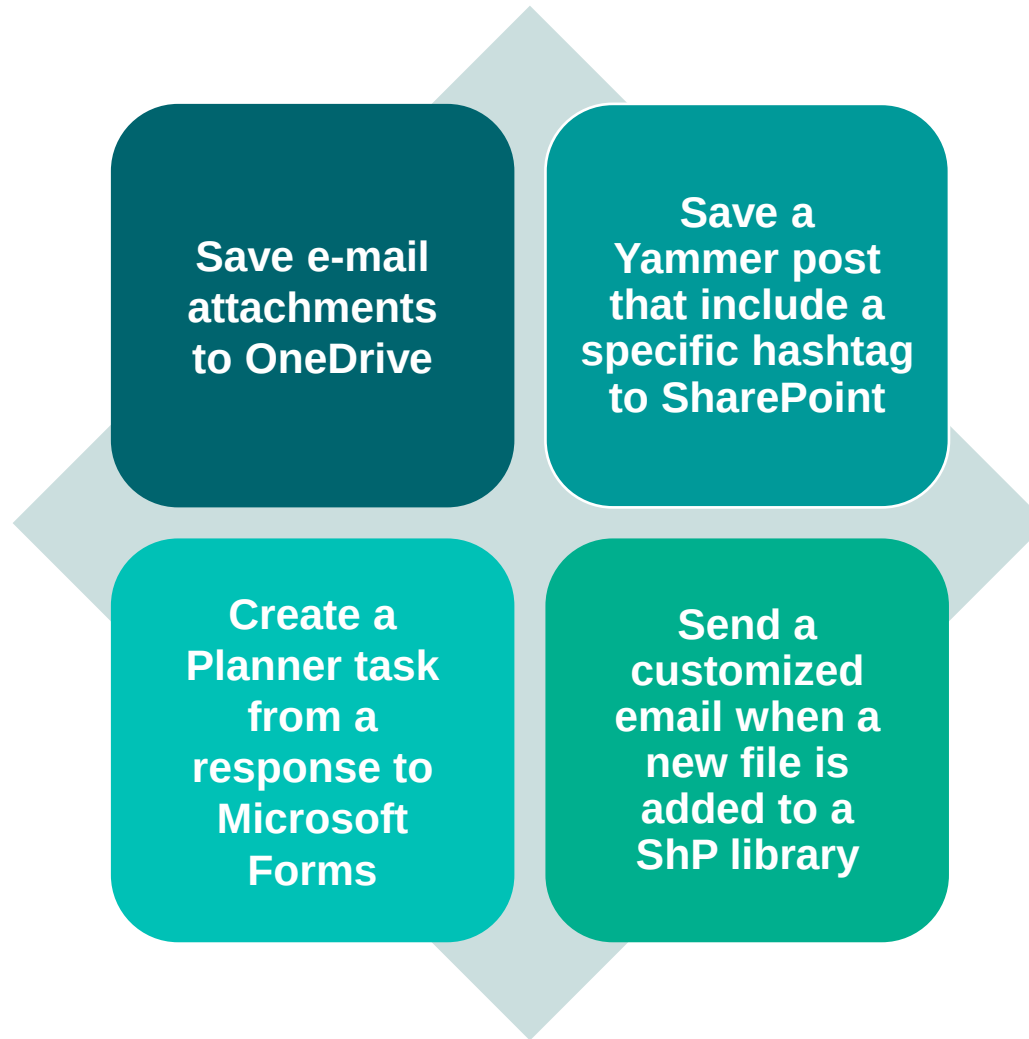

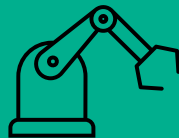

Cloud Flows

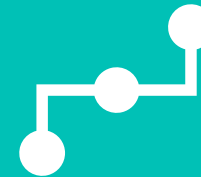

Consumer

- Uses Power BI service in a browser
- Explores reports and apps
- Can filter, save and share bookmarks



Data Analyst

- Uses Power BI Desktop tool
- Modifies data sets
- Creates reports and dashboards
- Creates new filters
