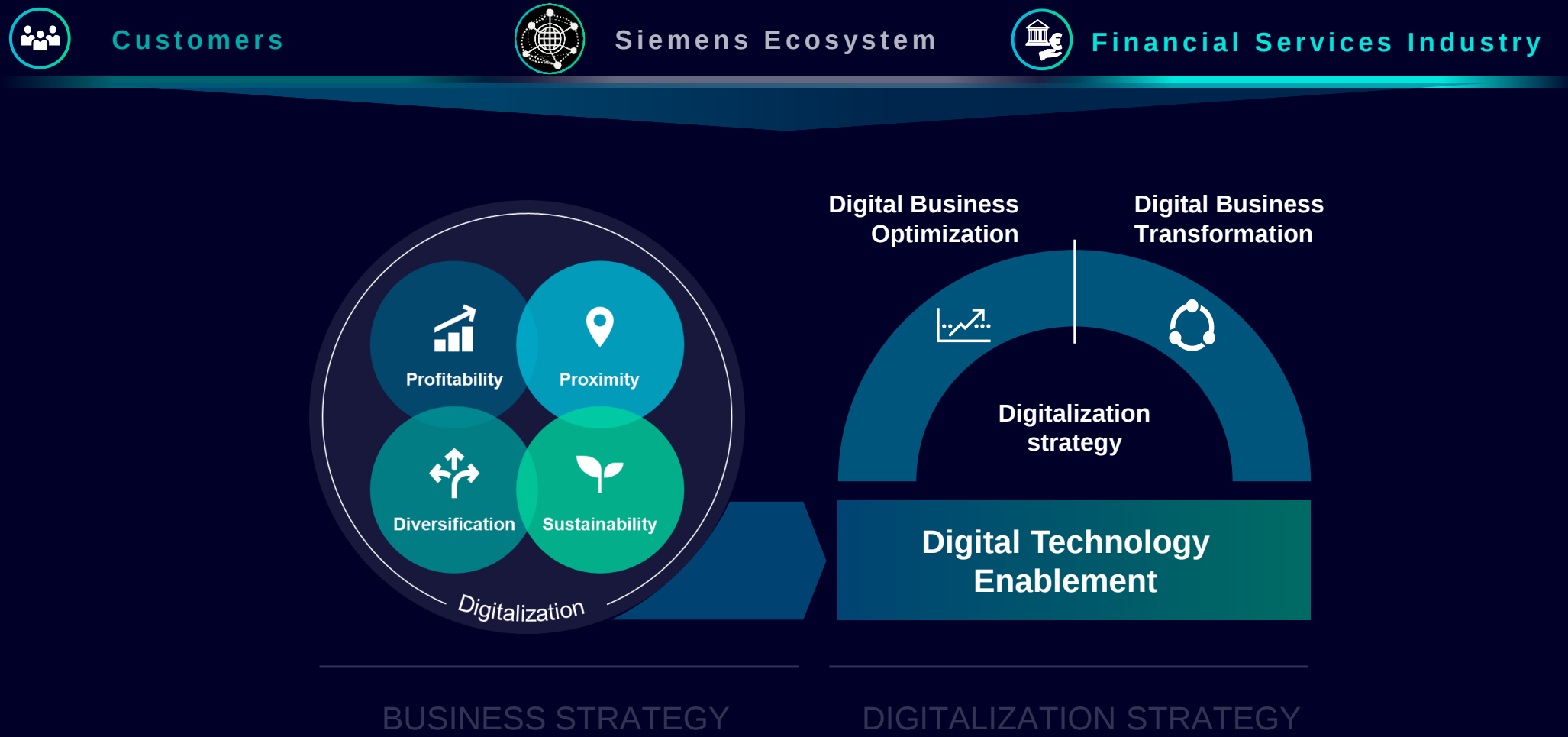

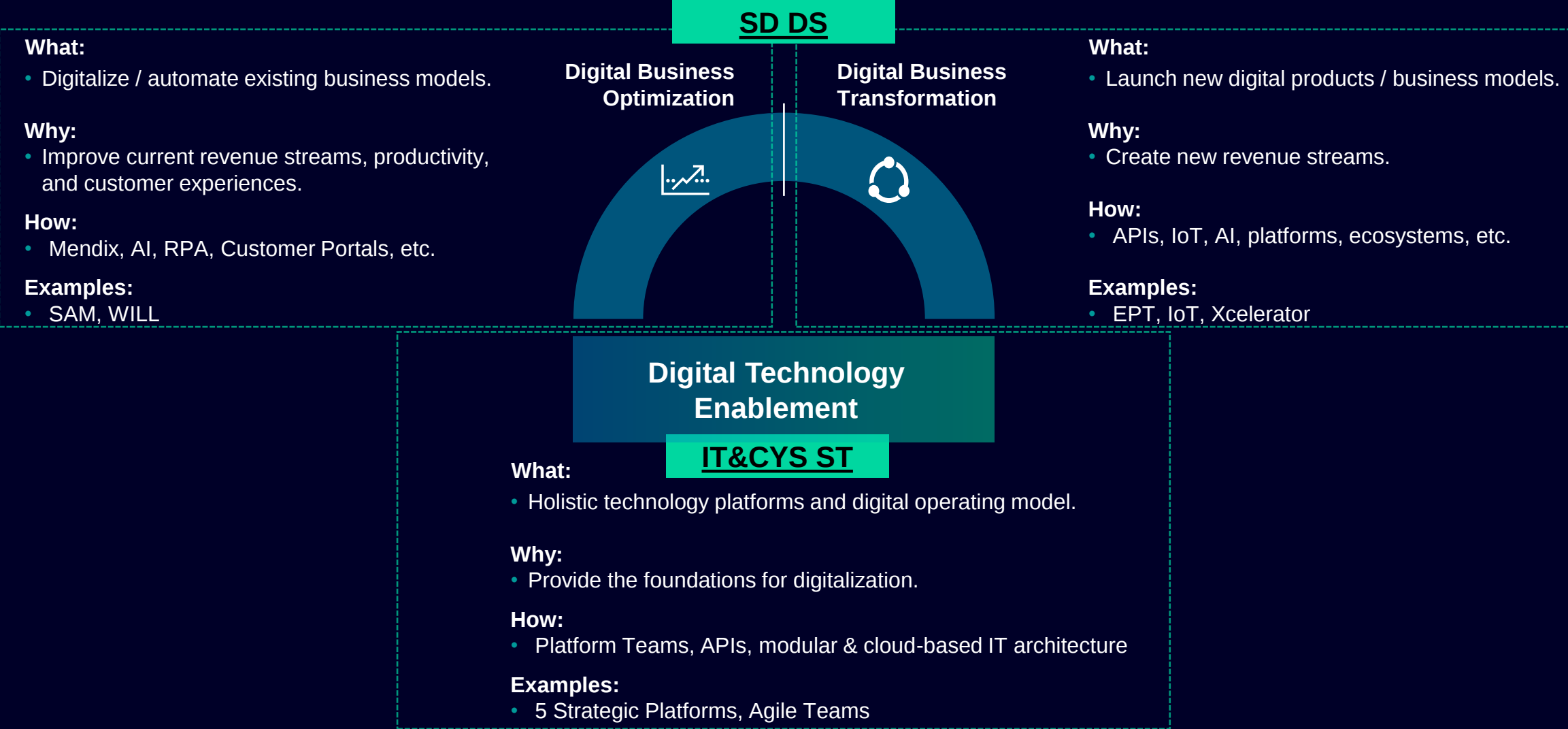

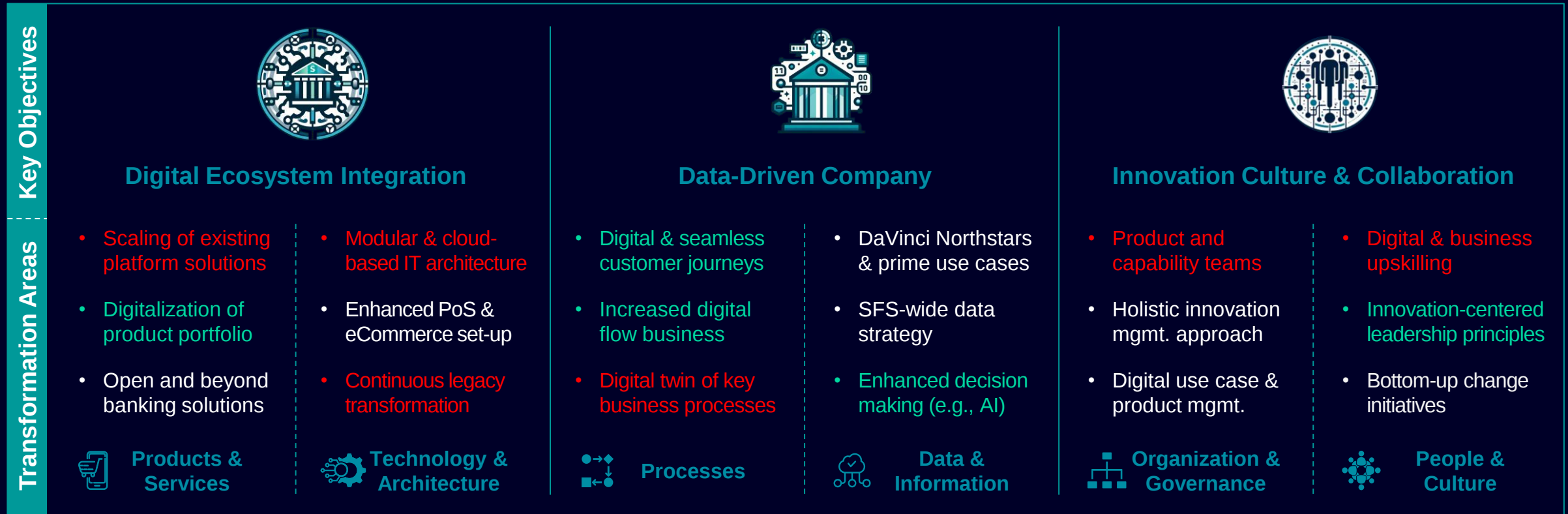
The 3 Levers of becoming more digital and Digitalization Strategy are Digital Business Optimization, Digital Business Transformation, and Digital Technology Enablement
